

## Spelling list: *are* words

In this list, we'll focus on words where the sound /air/ is spelled with *are* . Though these words are short, they are important!

Think of words like *bare* , *hare* , and *flare* , which you might encounter in both written and spoken language. Whether you're talking about something being *bare* of decoration or noticing the bright *flare* of a light, these words are common in everyday speech. The more you study these words, the quicker this spelling pattern will become second nature to you!

bare	The room was <b>bare</b> of all furniture.
dare	How <b>dare</b> you accuse me of that?
hare	The <b>hare</b> raced across the field to escape the fox.
pare	<b>Pare</b> the apple and cut out the core.
rare	Ben likes his steak cooked <b>rare</b> .
flare	We saw the fire <b>flare</b> up.
scare	That ride wouldn't <b>scare</b> me.
snare	The rabbit was trapped in a <b>snare</b> .
stare	Is it rude to <b>stare</b> ?
care	Take <b>care</b> not to skid on the ice.
fare	He lost his bus <b>fare</b> and had to walk all the way home.
mare	The <b>mare</b> took care of her new foal.
ware	She had a beautiful collection of crystal <b>ware</b> .
blare	I heard the <b>blare</b> of a siren whizzing past.
glare	The witch gave the little boy an evil <b>glare</b> .
share	I will <b>share</b> my dessert with him.
