

Spelling list: *ear* words

Let's take a look at some words that use *ear* to make the /air/ sound. This pattern is less common, but the words it appears in are very useful. Examples like *bear* , *wear* , and *pear* are all spelled with *ear* , and they're easy to learn once you understand the pattern. You might use *wear* when talking about clothes or *bear* when describing how much you can tolerate.

pear	Gemma's favourite pudding was pear tart.
swear	It's rather rude to swear .

wear	I wear gloves in the winter to keep my hands warm.
