

## Spelling list: *are* - longer words

In this list, you'll explore longer words that use the letters *are* to spell the /air/ sound. These words follow the same pattern as the shorter ones but can be a bit more challenging. Examples include *aware* , *prepare* , and *nightmare* . Whether you're *aware* of something, *preparing* for an exam, or recalling a bad *nightmare* , these words are useful in both writing and speech.

aware	Are you <b>aware</b> of the danger here?
beware	The sign warned us to <b>beware</b> of the bears.
compare	Let's <b>compare</b> scores.
declare	You must <b>declare</b> imported goods.
fanfare	The trumpets sounded a <b>fanfare</b> .
nightmare	The child woke up crying after he had a <b>nightmare</b> .
prepare	She is working hard to <b>prepare</b> for her test.
warfare	Modern <b>warfare</b> uses computers.
welfare	I care about the <b>welfare</b> of badly treated horses.
hardware	Computers need <b>hardware</b> and software.
software	Computers need hardware and <b>software</b> .
chinaware	The antique store had a lot of <b>chinaware</b> for sale.
glassware	<b>Glassware</b> must be packed very carefully.
ovenware	<b>Ovenware</b> must be able to stand a high heat.
silverware	The table was laid with fine <b>silverware</b> .
