

Spelling list: -ore words

If the sound /or/ is on the end of a word, it is usually spelled with the letters -ore . Some common examples include *shore* , *core* , and *store* . This spelling pattern helps distinguish these words from others that use *or* , *aw* , or *au* for the same sound. Learning this pattern will help improve spelling accuracy. Regular practice with spelling activities will reinforce your recognition of -ore words and their correct usage in writing.

ore	They mined for ore .
bore	He was a bore .
core	Peel the apple and cut out the core .
gore	This horror movie is full of blood and gore .
more	I need to get some more sleep.
chore	She made a chore chart for her children.
score	The teacher calculated the average test score for the class.
shore	We searched for shells along the shore .
snore	Shaun snores very loudly.
sore	I keep sneezing and my throat is sore .
store	I am taking my broken laptop back to the store .
tore	I tore my skirt on a nail.
