The /ut/ or /it/ ending is sometimes spelled -ite.

exquisite	The flowers you sent were <b>exquisite</b> .
favourite	His <b>favourite</b> lesson is Spanish.
granite	<b>Granite</b> is often used for kitchen countertops.
hypocrite	She's no friend, she's a <b>hypocrite</b> .
infinite	There are an <b>infinite</b> number of stars in the universe.
opposite	We met <b>opposite</b> the library.
requisite	This is the <b>requisite</b> album for music lovers.
