On the end of a word the most common way to spell the long /a/ sound is with the letters ay .

display	There was a display of books in the window.
decay	Brush your teeth every day to prevent decay .

Sunday	My Dad waxes his car every Sunday .
Monday	Do you look forward to work on a Monday ?
Tuesday	I'll meet you on Tuesday afternoon.

Friday	I'll shop for food on Friday .
Saturday	Jack goes to the pub every Saturday .
