| you're    | <b>You're</b> looking very smart today.  |
| weren't   | We <b>weren't</b> planning on going to the beach, but decided to make the most of a sunny day. |
| didn't    | His excuse <b>didn't</b> sound plausible.  |
| we're     | <b>We're</b> pleased to accept your invitation.  |
| they're   | I wonder why <b>they're</b> so late.   |
| mustn't   | You <b>mustn't</b> be late!  |
| who've    | <b>Who've</b> you got as your Science teacher this year?                                       |
| who's     | <b>Who's</b> that speaking?  |
| hasn't    | Your behaviour <b>hasn't</b> been appropriate today.   |
| you've    | I hope <b>you've</b> eaten because dinner won't be ready for hours.                            |
| you'll    | <b>You'll</b> need to shout to make him hear.  |
| weren't   | We <b>weren't</b> planning on going to the beach, but decided to make the most of a sunny day. |
| won't     | I hope you <b>won't</b> refuse my request.   |
| shouldn't | You <b>shouldn't</b> coerce people.  |
