

Spelling list: *our* and *oor* words

In this word list, we're exploring words that use *our* or *oor* to spell the /or/ sound. These letter combinations appear in many everyday words, from *four* to *floor*, and can be found in both familiar and more complex vocabulary. By learning how these patterns work, you'll be able to confidently spell and pronounce words like *court*, *mourn*, and *source*. Check out the examples below and see how these words come to life in different contexts!

four	He has read four books in a week.
pour	Please will you pour me a drink?
court	The tennis court was too wet for play.
course	This course should help your spelling.
mourn	The family should be able to mourn his death in peace.
source	The source of this river is in those hills.
door	The sign on the door said pull.
floor	I scrubbed the floor until it was spotless.
