

Spelling list: ow - longer words

To spell the sound /ou/ before the endings *e/* and *er* use *ow* . At the end of a word, or the end of a syllable, use *ow* .

cover	I cover in terror.
flower	There's a flower seller at the station.
power	It won't work if you don't switch on the power .
shower	I have a shower after football training.
tower	The tower was a unique construction.
towel	The baby was wrapped in a towel .
trowel	We use a trowel to put the cement on the bricks.
vowel	This course teaches you about vowels.
allow	The council won't allow any more houses here.
endow	A rich business man will endow our new town library.
eyebrow	She can raise one eyebrow at a time.
coward	He was considered to be a coward by his comrades.
powder	How much curry powder shall I use?
rowdy	His rowdy drunken shouting made us very angry.
