

Spelling list: Words ending in *-nce*

On the end of a word the /s/ sound after the letter *n* is most often spelled *ce* .

chance	He will forfeit his chance of promotion.
glance	At a glance , the man looked like someone she knew.
stance	She had an interesting stance on the matter.
advance	They planned the holiday well in advance .
instance	In this particular instance , the teacher let him off the hook for forgetting his homework.
fence	The fence was made of wood.
commence	Shall we commence the game?
sentence	I was gripped by the very first sentence of this book.
mince	We'll cook the mince tonight.
prince	The prince married his love.
convince	I had to convince Jim that he was wrong.
once	School photos are taken once a year.
ounce	An ounce is around 28 grams.
bounce	I bounce the ball against the wall.
pounce	That cat is about to pounce on a bird.
announce	When will you announce the date?
pronounce	How do you pronounce your name?
