stanza	A poem has a minimum of one <b>stanza</b> .
refrain	A <b>refrain</b> is like a chorus.
metaphor	Symbolism is an art style which uses mythology and <b>metaphor</b> to convey ideas.
simile	<b>Simile</b> involves describing something by comparing it with something else.
alliteration	<b>Alliteration</b> involves words that begin with the same sound.
hyperbole	<b>Hyperbole</b> is an exaggeration used for effect.
oxymoron	<b>Oxymoron</b> is where two words of contrasting meaning are adjacent to each other.
pathetic	<b>Pathetic</b> fallacy is using the weather to reflect emotions.
fallacy	Pathetic <b>fallacy</b> is using the weather to reflect emotions.
repetition	When words or phrases are repeated for effect we call it <b>repetition</b> .
caesura	<b>Caesura</b> is using a full stop in the middle of a line of poetry.
