| orbit     | It takes the Earth a year to <b>orbit</b> the sun.   |

| surface   | The stratosphere starts 10 kilometers above the earth's <b>surface</b> .   |
| globe     | The old <b>globe</b> show a map of the world 200 years ago.  |
| telescope | Use a <b>telescope</b> to see in the distance.   |
| astronaut | Tim peake is an <b>astronaut</b> .   |
| planet    | The continents have all shifted from where they were when the <b>planet</b> was created.   |
| Mercury   | <b>Mercury</b> is the closest planet to the sun.   |
| Venus     | <b>Venus</b> is the hottest planet in the solar system.  |
| Earth     | The <b>earth</b> is molten at the core.  |
