

# Spelling list: Words ending in *er*

The most common way to spell the /er/ sound on the end of a word is with the letters *er*. As you go through this list of er words, say each word aloud and listen to the weak vowel sound. Can you hear how it sounds slightly different to the er sound in the middle of a word (like in 'person')?

faster	The <b>faster</b> crew will win the race.
sharper	My pencil is <b>sharper</b> than yours.
lighter	In summer the days are <b>lighter</b> for longer.
smoother	My dog's coat is <b>smoother</b> than yours.
baker	Get me two loaves of bread from the <b>baker</b> .
driver	A good <b>driver</b> will pass other cars with care.
dancer	The <b>dancer</b> moved with great grace.
rider	The horse <b>rider</b> jumped the fence.
runner	Will is the fastest <b>runner</b> in the school.
swimmer	Champion <b>swimmers</b> have great strength.
teacher	The <b>teacher</b> gave me good advice.
daughter	Our <b>daughter</b> has fair hair.
lawyer	The arrested man asked for a <b>lawyer</b> .
writer	She is a skillful <b>writer</b> .
manager	The football <b>manager</b> was confident of winning.
publisher	A <b>publisher</b> will edit a book before printing it.
anger	I tried very hard to hide my <b>anger</b> .
answer	Please write your <b>answer</b> in the box.
deliver	When will you be able to <b>deliver</b> my order?
helicopter	The rescue <b>helicopter</b> pulled him from the sea.
