Spelling list: Words with doubled letters (Y6 2018)

These words are examples of the doubling rule: when a word ends in a short vowel and one consonant we must double the consonant when adding a vowel suffix.

flapping Stop **flapping** that paper at me.

getting My spelling is **getting** much better.

runner Will is the fastest **runner** in the school.

spotted We **spotted** a kingfisher on the river bank.

biggish I would like a **biggish** burger but not a huge one.

jogger That **jogger** covers five miles every day.

funny Bob's wedding speech was very **funny**.

snobbish I don't like **snobbish** people.

snappy He has a very **snappy** way of talking.

setting I took a great picture of the **setting** sun.

hidden I have **hidden** my sweets from my brother.

trodden I think you have **trodden** in something smelly.

dipped I **dipped** my foot in the freezing water.

travelled The cars **travelled** over the suspension bridge.

stopped The sailors **stopped** to work on the pontoon.
