

Spelling list: Words ending in *ssor* and *rror*

After the letters *ss* and *rr* many words use *or* to spell the weak vowel ending.

aggressor He was the **aggressor** in the argument.

assessor The **assessor** decided if the exam was fair to all.

confessor Edward the **Confessor** became King of England in 1003.

oppressor An **oppressor** does not allow people their freedom.

possessor **Possessor** is another word for owner.

predecessor My **predecessor** in this job was well respected.

processor I made this soup in a food **processor**.

professor The **professor** gave a lecture on ancient history.

successor My **successor** will work just as hard.

horror He was struck dumb with **horror**.

mirror He's admiring himself in the **mirror**.

error Did the **error** recur every time you logged on?

terror Her **terror** was evident in her voice.
