

## Spelling list: Words ending in *ssor* and *rror*

After the letters *ss* and *rr* many words use *or* to spell the weak vowel ending.

aggressor	He was the <b>aggressor</b> in the argument.
assessor	How long will it take to get an <b>assessor</b> for this job?
confessor	The <b>confessor</b> changed his story.
oppressor	The ruler was known to be an <b>oppressor</b> .
possessor	She was the <b>possessor</b> of a large fortune.
predecessor	He was concerned that he would be overshadowed by his <b>predecessor</b> .
processor	I made this soup in a food <b>processor</b> .
professor	The <b>professor</b> gave a lecture on ancient history.
successor	My <b>successor</b> will work just as hard.
horror	The <b>horror</b> film made me squirm.
mirror	We have a large <b>mirror</b> in our hall.
error	He couldn't believe the spelling <b>error</b> he had made.
terror	Her <b>terror</b> was evident in her voice.
