

## Spelling list: Words ending in *our*

Another way of spelling the weak vowel ending is with the letters *our* . Please note: these words have the British English spelling

armour	The armadillo has a leathery <b>armour</b> shell.
clamour	There was a <b>clamour</b> from the crowd at the bad news.
endeavour	I will <b>endeavour</b> to win at all costs.
flavour	I add salt to improve the <b>flavour</b> .
glamour	The young actor was attracted by the <b>glamour</b> of Hollywood.
harbour	The fishing boats spent the night in <b>harbour</b> .
honour	She hoped the ceremony would <b>honour</b> her father's memory.
humour	Pete has a wry sense of <b>humour</b> .
labour	Many companies rely on <b>labour</b> from other countries.
neighbour	Our new <b>neighbour</b> seems very nice.
odour	Bad eggs have a dreadful <b>odour</b> .
rumour	There's a <b>rumour</b> spreading about our teacher.
savour	He wanted to <b>savour</b> every moment.
splendour	The <b>splendour</b> of the palace was amazing.
valour	He was given a medal for his <b>valour</b> .
vapour	Clouds are made from water <b>vapour</b> .
vigour	He approached his task with <b>vigour</b> .
behaviour	His <b>behaviour</b> was obnoxious.
