

Spelling list: Words ending in *ery*

In these words the weak vowel sound before *y* is spelled with the letters *er* , making the ending *ery* .

archery	The princess excelled at archery .
artery	The main artery carries blood from the heart.
battery	The car battery has run dry.
celery	He doesn't like celery in a salad.
cemetery	The dead are buried in a cemetery .
crockery	Plates, cups and saucers are known as crockery .
cutlery	The maid polished the silver cutlery .

forgery	The banknote was a forgery .

lottery	He thought he had a clever scheme to win the lottery .
