

## Spelling list: Suffix -ly

Notice how these words are turned into adverbs by using the -ly suffix.

sadly	<b>Sadly</b> I was busy and couldn't make the party.
madly	The girls <b>madly</b> wanted to see the pop group.
badly	His dad will rebuke him for behaving <b>badly</b> .
slowly	The river flows <b>slowly</b> here.
quickly	Our baby has grown so <b>quickly</b> .
shyly	The girl <b>shyly</b> answered the question.
quietly	The old lady was humming <b>quietly</b> .
strangely	We all agreed that the boy had been behaving rather <b>strangely</b> .
happily	The children <b>happily</b> went out to play.
angrily	The man and his co-defendant looked at the judge <b>angrily</b> .
