

Spelling list: Words ending in *ble*

The /b l/ sound at the end of a word is usually spelled *ble* .

bible	What is your favourite bible passage?
cable	Is this cable long enough to reach the TV?
noble	His bravery was a noble act.
table	The waiter brushed the crumb off the table .
bobble	The baby's woollen hat has a blue bobble .
hobble	My sore ankle made me hobble .
wobble	The girl shook the jelly and made it wobble .
nibble	Peter couldn't resist having a nibble of his biscuit.
scribble	I scribble down the recipe.
bubble	There was a bubble of soap floating through the kitchen.
wobble	The girl shook the jelly and made it wobble .
double	I have a double bed in my bedroom.
trouble	I hope you won't get in trouble .
scrabble	A hen will scrabble in the dust for corn.
gamble	He likes to gamble at the casino.
ramble	We like to ramble through the woods.
scramble	We scramble up the hill.
tumble	The child had a tumble and began to cry.
grumble	Grandad will grumble about everything.
