

Spelling list: Words ending in *cle*

The /k l/ sound at the end of a word can be spelled *cle*, especially if the word has more than two syllables.

circle I have a wide **circle** of friends.

cycle I prefer to **cycle** to work rather than going by bus.

treacle **Treacle** is sweet, black and sticky.

uncle **Uncle** Bill is my closest relative.

article James wrote an **article** for the college magazine.

icicle After the freezing night, **icicles** hung from the window.

particle A **particle** is a tiny fragment such as a speck of dust.

cubicle Lucy changed her clothes in the **cubicle**.

vehicle Good locks can deter **vehicle** theft.

miracle It was a **miracle** that he was not hurt.

obstacle The next event was the **obstacle** course.

pinnacle The **pinnacle** of the rock was dangerously pointy.

spectacle The fireworks were a wonderful **spectacle**.

tentacle An octopus has eight **tentacles**.
