

## Spelling list: Words ending in *dle*

The /d l/ sound at the end of a word is usually spelled *dle* .

cradle	Each baby was placed in a <b>cradle</b> .
ladle	<b>Ladle</b> the soup into a bowl.
doodle	The artist was bored so she drew a quick <b>doodle</b> .
noodle	I use a <b>noodle</b> to help me float in the swimming pool.
poodle	Her first dog was a <b>poodle</b> .
needle	It's like finding a <b>needle</b> in a haystack.
paddle	It was a beautiful day to <b>paddle</b> in the sea.
fiddle	A violin is sometimes called a <b>fiddle</b> .
middle	Central Park is in the <b>middle</b> of New York City.
riddle	Can you solve the <b>riddle</b> ?
cuddle	The baby would like a <b>cuddle</b> .
muddle	The recipe was complicated and the chef got into a <b>muddle</b> .
puddle	I jumped in the <b>puddle</b> .
candle	Be careful not to burn yourself on the <b>candle</b> .
handle	Grip the <b>handle</b> with both hands.
dwindle	The resort's population will <b>dwindle</b> in winter.
swindle	The businessman was planning to <b>swindle</b> the investors.
bundle	I gathered a <b>bundle</b> of sticks for the fire.
hurdle	She overcame each <b>hurdle</b> .
