

## Spelling list: Words ending in *tle*

The /t l/ sound at the end of a word is usually spelled *tle* .

bottle	I filled my water <b>bottle</b> before we left.
title	They couldn't decide on a <b>title</b> for the book.
beetle	The <b>beetle</b> was black and shiny.
battle	The soldiers were courageous in <b>battle</b> .
cattle	The local farmer reared <b>cattle</b> .
rattle	The baby shook her <b>rattle</b> .
kettle	He turned on the <b>kettle</b> .
nettle	Would you like some <b>nettle</b> soup?
settle	They were unable to <b>settle</b> the argument.
little	The sea is a <b>little</b> way from the path.
brittle	Wine glasses can be very <b>brittle</b> .
skittle	At the bowling alley, I knocked over a <b>skittle</b> .
mottle	The leaves weren't just one colour, but a <b>mottle</b> of dark green and purple.
throttle	The engines were at full <b>throttle</b> .
scuttle	We watch the beetle <b>scuttle</b> away.
shuttle	The <b>shuttle</b> took the astronauts to the space station.
gentle	I used a <b>gentle</b> soap to cleanse my face.
startle	Loud bangs <b>startle</b> my dog.
hurtle	They <b>hurtle</b> to the station, afraid of missing the last train.
