

## Spelling list: The /r l/ sound after r

To spell the sound /r l/ at the end of a word use *al* or *el* .

admiral	The <b>admiral</b> led his fleet to war.
cathedral	Have you visited York's <b>cathedral</b> ?
coral	Many types of fish live in <b>coral</b> .
corporal	The <b>corporal</b> saluted the major.
federal	She worked for the <b>federal</b> government.
floral	We bought <b>floral</b> curtains for the bedroom.
funeral	The mood at the <b>funeral</b> was sombre.
general	The <b>general</b> mood in the country seemed to have improved.
liberal	Her politics are <b>liberal</b> .
mineral	Quartz is a hard transparent <b>mineral</b> .
natural	Fabric can be made from <b>natural</b> or man-made fibers.
numeral	The decimal <b>numeral</b> system has ten as its base.
several	The process of buying a house can take <b>several</b> months.
barrel	They bought a whole <b>barrel</b> of wine.
cockerel	The <b>cockerel</b> wakes me up every morning.
quarrel	The boys began to <b>quarrel</b> about the toys.
squirrel	The red <b>squirrel</b> is an endangered species.
