parallel	A trapezoid or trapezium is a type of quadrilateral with at least one pair of <b>parallel</b> sides.
parallelogram	A <b>parallelogram</b> is a four-sided shape with opposite sides equal and parallel.
negative	<b>Negative</b> numbers are number less than zero.
numerator	A fraction has a <b>numerator</b> and a denominator.
percentage	I worked out the <b>percentage</b> of people with purple jumpers.
perimeter	Add all the sides of a shape to get the <b>perimeter</b> .
perpendicular	<b>Perpendicular</b> is exactly upright, at right angles to the base.
positive	<b>Positive</b> numbers are numbers more than zero.
quadrilateral	A trapezoid or trapezium is a type of <b>quadrilateral</b> with at least one pair of parallel sides.

radius	The <b>radius</b> is a line from one side of a circle to the centre.
