

## Spelling list: *-ence* words, Set 2 (copy)

In these words the weak vowel sound in the final syllable is spelled with the letter *e* . These are just a few of the many words ending in *-ence* .

audience	The <b>audience</b> ignored the speaker.
circumference	The <b>circumference</b> of the circle was large.
conference	We attended the <b>conference</b> in Chicago.
conscience	My <b>conscience</b> is completely clear.
essence	Endeavour is the <b>essence</b> of success.
experience	The cooks traveled the world to <b>experience</b> authentic native cuisines.
innocence	The man appealed at court to prove his <b>innocence</b> .
intelligence	The <b>intelligence</b> team decoded the cipher easily.
interference	He focused on his work without the <b>interference</b> of television.
persistence	Through the <b>persistence</b> of his efforts he achieved his goal.
reference	If you are stuck, use the instruction book for <b>reference</b> .
residence	He took up <b>residence</b> in New York.
science	Rocket <b>science</b> enabled space travel.
sentence	This is the tenth <b>sentence</b> of this test.
sequence	A byte is a <b>sequence</b> of 8 bits. (Computer data terminology).
silence	Some monks make a vow of <b>silence</b> .
succulence	Each bite of fruit was full of <b>succulence</b> .
turbulence	The aeroplane experienced some <b>turbulence</b> .
