

Spelling list: Long /oo/ spelled oo

The most common way of spelling the long /oo/ sound is to use the letters oo . This list has some more examples.

loose	The wire on the plug is loose .
moose	A moose is a large brown deer.
noose	The noose tightened.
goose	The magic goose laid golden eggs.
doodle	The artist was bored so she drew a quick doodle .
poodle	Her first dog was a poodle .
baboon	In the zoo, they went to see the baboon first.
raccoon	The camp was ambushed by a wild raccoon .
balloon	The family took a ride in a hot-air balloon .
cartoon	When they got home from school the kids watched a cartoon .
lagoon	We swam in the warm water of the lagoon .
monsoon	There may be floods in the monsoon season.
bamboo	The panda loves to eat bamboo .
kangaroo	Did you see a kangaroo during your visit to Australia?
shampoo	What shampoo do you use?
tattoo	He disliked his new tattoo .
