repetition	Repetition of the same word(s) at the beginning of a series of phrases or lines.
technique	We all admired the wood-carver's technique .
onomatopoeia	Onomatopoeia is when it sounds like the word, for example bang.
immediately	The troop of soldiers were told to cease fire immediately .
fascinate	I think this new game will fascinate your child.
minutes	That clock is ten minutes slow.
desperate	I'm desperate for a long cold drink.
embarrass	Sorry to embarrass you.
especially	It was especially hot this August.
efficient	An efficient machine works well.
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unflinching	Not showing fear or hesitation in the face of danger or difficulty: for example, they stood together in unflinching determination to win.
torrid	Very hot and dry: for example, the weather was torrid .
fulfilled	I am not fulfilled by my job.
juxtaposition	Juxtaposition means ' putting next to'.
