repetition	<b>Repetition</b> of the same word(s) at the beginning of a series of phrases or lines.
technique	We all admired the wood-carver's <b>technique</b> .
onomatopoeia	<b>Onomatopoeia</b> is when it sounds like the word, for example bang.
immediately	The troop of soldiers were told to cease fire <b>immediately</b> .
fascinate	I think this new game will <b>fascinate</b> your child.
minutes	That clock is ten <b>minutes</b> slow.
desperate	I'm <b>desperate</b> for a long cold drink.
embarrass	Sorry to <b>embarrass</b> you.
especially	It was <b>especially</b> hot this August.
efficient	An <b>efficient</b> machine works well.
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unflinching	Not showing fear or hesitation in the face of danger or difficulty: for example, they stood together in <b>unflinching</b> determination to win.
torrid	Very hot and dry: for example, the weather was <b>torrid</b> .
fulfilled	I am not <b>fulfilled</b> by my job.
juxtaposition	<b>Juxtaposition</b> means ' putting next to'.
