

## Spelling list: -ancy words

Some words ending in *-ant* are changed to nouns by using the ending *-ancy* .

accountancy	He owned a large <b>accountancy</b> firm.
buoyancy	He greeted everybody with much <b>buoyancy</b> .
discrepancy	There was a <b>discrepancy</b> in the company finances.
flippancy	There should be no <b>flippancy</b> during church services.
hesitancy	<b>Hesitancy</b> to answer questions might be seen as suspicious.
infancy	We learn to talk during our <b>infancy</b> .
malignancy	<b>Malignancy</b> is the presence of a cancerous tumour.
militancy	The crowds protested with <b>militancy</b> .
redundancy	Every year, many people face <b>redundancy</b> .
tenancy	I currently have <b>tenancy</b> of a flat in the city.
truancy	<b>Truancy</b> will not be tolerated in this school.
vacancy	The hotel only had one <b>vacancy</b> .
