

Spelling list: Algebra- Equations, formulae and identities

equations	We can often solve two simultaneous equations by looking at them at the same time and trying to eliminate part of them.
formulae	Formulae (plural for formula) are special types of equation that show the relationship between different variables.
algebra	Algebra is heavily used in the electrical, chemical and physics industries.
brackets	The 'B' in BODMAS stands for brackets .
commutative	Commutative means we can swap the numbers around in addition or multiplication and still get the same answer.
equation	An equation is a statement that two expressions are equal and we are often asked to solve them.
expression	In maths, substitution is often used to replace an expression with a number.
evaluate	If you evaluate something, you explain what makes it good or bad in your opinion.
prove	Can you prove you are over 18?
simplify	Can you simplify the text for him?
symbol	This symbol means 'add' : +.
unknown	The actual results were unknown .
variable	A variable is an alphabetic character representing a number.
value	The approximate value for the house was \$300,000.
