Language devices

conjunction	A conjunction is a word that joins other words together.
repetition	When a word is used more than once, it is called repetition .
direct	Direct speech involves the narrator giving the exact words spoken (or thought) by the character, almost always enclosed in speech marks, and often (but not always) with a reporting clause (such as 'said Jim').
indirect	Indirect speech involves the narrator summarising or paraphrasing the speech (or thought) of a character, without actually quoting the character's exact words.
punctuation	Use of punctuation in the middle of a line to create a pause.
vocabulary	Vocabulary means the words in a language.
imagery	The effective use of the adjective 'beautiful' help to create imagery for the reader.
emotive	Emotive language is language used to create emotion in the reader.
possibility	A verb which expresses necessity or possibility e.g. might, could, should.
