### English words

preposition	A <b>preposition</b> precedes a noun.
resolution	The more pixels, the better the <b>resolution</b> .
rhyme	Time, crime and chime all <b>rhyme</b> .
scene	The picture showed a peaceful country <b>scene</b> .
simile	<b>Simile</b> involves describing something by comparing it with something else.
soliloquy	Shakespeare uses Macbeth's <b>soliloquy</b> to show that he is unsure about what to do.
subordinate	In Imperial China women were considered to be <b>subordinate</b> [ of an inferior status] to men.
suffix	A <b>suffix</b> goes at the end of a root word.
synonym	A <b>synonym</b> is a word with the same or similar meaning to another word.
tabloid	<b>Tabloid</b> newspapers tend to have more pictures.
vocabulary	Use a thesaurus to widen your <b>vocabulary</b> .
vowel	Assonance involves words that have the same <b>vowel</b> sound.
