

Spelling list: Shape, space and measures

Adjacent	The opposite, adjacent and hypotenuse of a right-angled triangle can be used to solve trigonometry questions.
Acute	An acute angle is less than 90 degrees.
Horizontal	A line that runs from the left and right of the page.
Vertical	A line that runs from the top and bottom of the page.
Parallel	When two objects run alongside each other but do not meet; parallel sound means sound that suits the scene.
Perpendicular	A perpendicular bisector is a line that cuts another in half, crossing it at right angles.
Quadrilateral	A quadrilateral is the collective name for 2-dimensional shapes that have four sides.
Obtuse	An obtuse angle is more than 90 degrees.
Reflex	A reflex angle is between 180 and 360 degrees.
