| Adjacent | The opposite, adjacent and hypotenuse of a right-angled triangle can be used to solve trigonometry questions. |

| Acute | An acute angle is less than 90 degrees. |
| Horizontal | A line that runs from the left and right of the page. |
| Vertical | A line that runs from the top and bottom of the page. |
| Parallel | When two objects run alongside each other but do not meet; parallel sound means sound that suits the scene. |
| Perpendicular | A perpendicular bisector is a line that cuts another in half, crossing it at right angles. |
| Quadrilateral | A quadrilateral is the collective name for 2-dimensional shapes that have four sides. |
| Obtuse | An obtuse angle is more than 90 degrees. |
| Reflex | A reflex angle is between 180 and 360 degrees. |
