

## Spelling list: Numbers and the number system - Place value, ordering and rounding

Ascending	Numbers in <b>ascending</b> order would be from smallest to largest - for example 5,10,15,20.
Descending	Numbers in <b>descending</b> order would be from largest to smallest - for example 9,7,5,3.
Billion	A <b>billion</b> would be a starting number followed by 9 more numbers - for example one <b>billion</b> is 1,000,000,000.
Index	The <b>index</b> of a number says how many times to use the number in a multiplication.
Power	The <b>power</b> of a number says how many times to use the number in a multiplication.
Rounding	<b>Rounding</b> numbers e.g. to the nearest ten, unit or decimal place.
Ordering	To arrange numbers a certain way, whether this be ascending (smallest to largest), or descending (largest to smallest).
