

## Spelling list: Resistant Materials

Technical language for RM

malleable	<b>Malleable</b> means a substance can be easily hammered into different shapes.
ductile	Solid material is <b>ductile</b> if it can be stretched in to a wire.
tough	This meat is far too <b>tough</b> to eat.
brittle	Wine glasses can be very <b>brittle</b> .
wrought	The old gate is made of <b>wrought</b> iron.
corrosion	The acid caused <b>corrosion</b> .
armour	The armadillo has a leathery <b>armour</b> shell.
panel	Use the Options <b>Panel</b> to adjust alignment, size and other text properties.
welding	Joining to pieces of metal together by melting is called <b>welding</b> .
pewter	The buckle was made of <b>pewter</b> .
titanium	<b>Titanium</b> is a very strong element often used in aircrafts.
tungsten	<b>Tungsten</b> is a dull silver metal with the highest melting point of any pure metal.
