

## Spelling list: Non-statutory words: -tch

This sound is usually spelt as tch if it comes straight after a single vowel letter. Exceptions: rich, which, much, such.

catch                      Many people **catch** flu each winter.

fetch                      Robert threw the ball and his dog ran to **fetch** it.

kitchen                    A dishwasher is a **kitchen** appliance.

notch                      Another **notch** on his belt.

hutch                      My father built a **hutch** for the rabbit.
