Adding the endings ing, ed and er to verbs where no change is needed to the root word.

hunting	The wolf cub can't go hunting yet.
hunted	In the old film the sheriff hunted the outlaw.
buzzing	The crowd was buzzing with excitement.
buzzer	Press the buzzer on counter to get served.
jumping	Freya likes jumping on the trampoline.
jumped	She jumped up and down.
jumper	Please don't shrink my jumper mum!
hunter	The gun belonged to the hunter .
buzzed	A wasp buzzed around my head.
