say	<b>Say</b> shoo to get rid of the birds.
way	Which <b>way</b> shall we go?
stay	<b>Stay</b> for a little longer.
boy	The <b>boy</b> ate his ice-cream using a spoon.
toy	Our baby is fascinated by that <b>toy</b> .
enjoy	In my leisure time I <b>enjoy</b> swimming.
annoy	Why do you have to <b>annoy</b> me?
day	In summer the days are lighter for longer.
