

Spelling list: Non-statutory words: using k for the /k/ sound

The /k/ sound is spelt as k rather than as c before e, i and y.

Kent	His family lived near Kent .
sketch	Kate drew a sketch of her brother.
kit	Your mum and dad must be too poor to afford a good PE kit .
skin	Sebaceous glands provide oil for skin and hair.
frisky	Charlie's dog was frisky by nature.
