

Spelling list: Non-statutory words: -ing, -ed, -er, -est and -y #2

In these words, the last consonant letter of the root word is doubled.

patting	She kept her dog happy by patting its head.
patted	He patted the ground with a shovel.
humming	I walked along humming a happy tune.
dropping	Mary kept dropping the netball today.
dropped	Whilst eating a meal, he dropped a noodle.
sadder	The dog was sadder when he was left on his own.
runner	The runner showed great endurance.
runny	The cake mixture was too runny .
