

## Spelling list: Non-statutory words: the suffix -ly

The suffix ly is added to an adjective to form an adverb.

sadly	Tragedy is a story or play which tells of terrible events and usually ends <b>sadly</b> .
completely	My conscience is <b>completely</b> clear.
usually	Puppies are <b>usually</b> excitable.
finally	The group <b>finally</b> reached safety.
comically	He tumbled over <b>comically</b> .
