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| happily      | The girls <b>happily</b> skipped across the playground.  |
| angrily      | This is totally karma, she told herself <b>angrily</b> .   |
| gently       | The wind blew <b>gently</b> over the beach.  |
| simply       | Water vapour is <b>simply</b> water in the form of a gas. Liquid water turns into water vapour through a process called evaporation. |
| humbly       | The performer bowed <b>humbly</b> .  |
| nobly        | He stepped down from the position <b>nobly</b> .   |
| basically    | Because she left he was <b>basically</b> the boss now.   |
| frantically  | He waved his arms <b>frantically</b> .   |
| dramatically | The football team lost <b>dramatically</b> .   |
| publicly     | The candidates have <b>publicly</b> excoriated each other throughout the campaign.   |
| truly        | Their wedding was a <b>truly</b> joyous occasion.  |
| duly         | She <b>duly</b> arrived at the appointment on time.  |
| wholly       | I <b>wholly</b> agree with you.  |
