

## Spelling list: Non-statutory words: adding -er and -est to adjectives

Adding er and est to adjectives where no change is needed to the root word. If the adjective ends in two consonant letters (the same or different), the ending is simply added on.

fresher	I feel much <b>fresher</b> after a bath.
quicker	You might get your work done <b>quicker</b> if you stopped talking.
quickest	Peter was the <b>quickest</b> to get changed after swimming.
grander	The station building was <b>grander</b> than town hall.
grandest	The hotel was the <b>grandest</b> in the city.
freshest	She wanted the <b>freshest</b> bread in the bakery.
