Adding the prefix im- (before a root word starting with m or p)

immature	The children were silly and immature .

impossible	It's impossible to hear you.

imperfect	It didn't fit because it was imperfect .
impatient	She was feeling impatient and tired of waiting.
immovable	The removal men said that the bookcase was completely immovable .
impolite	She was impolite and really quite rude.
important	A General is an important army officer.
