Adding suffixes that begin with vowels to single syllable base words

digging	My dog was digging in our yard after the heavy rains.
whipped	She shivered as a cold breeze whipped through the trees.
swimming	In my leisure time I enjoy swimming .
trimmed	I trimmed the low branches off the tree.
stopped	He stopped the car suddenly.
drumming	My sister annoyed me by drumming her pencil on the counter while I did my homework.
bagged	Our groceries were bagged and loaded into our car.
skinned	I skinned my knee when I fell off my bike.
shopping	The shopping mall is closed today.
flatten	I prefer to flatten my pancakes instead of letting them become fluffy.
hopping	She was hopping because she hurt her foot.
clipped	I clipped my fingernails because they were getting too long.
