

## Spelling list: oi and oy words (copy)

In one-syllable words, there are two ways of spelling the /oi/ sound: oi and oy. Use oi in the middle of a word and oy at the end. This list will help you practise spelling the oi sound in a mixture of oi and oy words.

boil	Let the water <b>boil</b> before making tea.
foil	Cover the meat with <b>foil</b> to keep it warm.
soil	This garden <b>soil</b> is good quality.
spoil	Please don't <b>spoil</b> the game by cheating.
toil	<b>Toil</b> means to work long and hard.
coin	Toss a <b>coin</b> to see who pays the bill.
join	Let's all <b>join</b> in the singing.
loin	<b>Loin</b> of lamb is a very tender meat.
joint	My hip <b>joint</b> is hurting after that long run.
void	<b>Void</b> means empty or invalid.
hoist	Use a <b>hoist</b> to lift a heavy weight.
joist	You need a new <b>joist</b> fitted above that door.
moist	This chocolate cake is very <b>moist</b> .
choice	There's a <b>choice</b> of four desserts.
voice	I've a sore throat and I've lost my <b>voice</b> .
noise	Did you hear that strange <b>noise</b> ?
boy	The new <b>boy</b> in school was named Luke.
joy	The baby has brought them great <b>joy</b> .
toy	That child has far too many toys.
