Spelling list: Doubling final consonant

If the last letter is a consonant and has a vowel before it the final letter is doubled.

forgetting She is always **forgetting** where she has put her keys.

forgotten You might have **forgotten**.

beginning My hair is **beginning** to go grey.

preferred She **preferred** cake to pudding.

permitted It is not **permitted** to eat chewing gum in school.

regretting Macbeth ends up **regretting** what he has done.

committed Henry **committed** a serious crime - he forgot to say thank you!

forbidden Nuts are **forbidden** in school.

propelled The ship was **propelled** by the rota.

equipped The kitchen is well **equipped**.
