

Spelling list: Doubling final consonant

If the last letter is a consonant and has a vowel before it the final letter is doubled.

forgetting	She is always forgetting where she has put her keys.
forgotten	You might have forgotten .
beginning	My hair is beginning to go grey.
preferred	She preferred cake to pudding.
permitted	It is not permitted to eat chewing gum in school.
regretting	Macbeth ends up regretting what he has done.
committed	Henry committed a serious crime - he forgot to say thank you!
forbidden	Nuts are forbidden in school.
propelled	The ship was propelled by the rota.
equipped	The kitchen is well equipped .
